[BNSF Dedicates New Intermodal Facility, Calls It World's Most Modern \(The Commercial Appeal\)](http://www.commercialappeal.com/news/2010/apr/22/economic-lift/)

BNSF Railway on Wednesday dedicated a \$200 million intermodal facility that is expected to drive profits for Warren Buffett's railroad and generate income for Memphians for decades to come. Railroad, government and economic-development officials celebrated completion of a seven-year effort leading to what BNSF says is the most modern facility of its kind in the world. The intermodal hub at 4814 Lamar is BNSF's supersized replacement for the old Tennessee Yards off Shelby Drive and Harvard Yards in Marion, Ark. Sprawling along Lamar from South Perkins to Shelby Drive with 90-foot-tall cranes forming a new skyline, the facility handles cargo containers that move by rail, road and ocean.
